## Understanding Your Roles

*Child of God*

The **MOST IMPORTANT** role is understanding your identity in Christ

Jesus knew who He was.... Luke 4:18-21

John the Baptist knew who he was ... John 1:6, 19-23

Where did Jesus and John the Baptist find their identity?

The Word of God, declared out of the mouth of Prophets from old!

**Your identity and your purpose are going to be found in Who God is!**

When you find out who you are it brings **stability, fulfillment, and security**. Then you become effective and fruitful for the Kingdom. This also brings success in your life.

**The Supreme Advantage in life...** Is knowing God intimately

Philippians 3:8-10 Amplified Version

I count every thing as loss compared to the possession of the priceless privilege (the overwhelming preciousness, the surpassing worth, and supreme advantage) of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord and of progressively becoming more deeply and intimately acquainted with Him [of **perceiving** and **recognizing** and **understanding** Him more fully and clearly.] For His sake I have lost everything and consider it all to be mere rubbish in order that I may **gain Christ**. And that I may [actually] **be found and known as in Him**, not having any [self-achieved] righteousness that can be called my own, based on my obedience to the Law's demands, but **possessing** that [**genuine righteousness** which comes **through faith in Christ**. For **my determined purpose** is that I may know Him [that I may progressively become more deeply and intimately acquainted with Him, perceiving and recognizing and understanding the wonders of His person more strongly and more clearly], and that I may in that same way come to know the power outflowing from His resurrection [which it exerts over believers], and that I may so share His sufferings as to be continually transformed into His likeness."

**I am my Father's daughter...** He can only be to me what I know Him to be.

What do you know of God? **(Ask the class to share attribute of God's nature.)**

How does God view you? **(Ask a student to read the following Scripture References)**

The King's daughters are honorable women... Psalm 45:9

Pillars sculptured in palace style... Psalm 144:12

**What does the pillar represent?** Prominence, strength, stability

**Name a woman in the Bible this Scripture references.** The Proverbs 31 Women!

**How can I be a woman like this ?**

- 1) God must come first in your life!

Matthew 6:33

**“...seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.”**

If you settle this right now it will be the basis and foundation for your role in every relationship throughout your life.

- 2) Put to practice the activities defined by Scripture.

This is who I am and it will righteously define every relationship.
